

Camp Parole May 11th 1864

Dear Parents & Sister

Tell us are exchanged
An order has just been read
to us to that effect. And
all men belonging to the army
of the Potomac are to hold
themselves in readiness to join
their Reg^{ts}. So I suppose we
shall have to go immediately
I have not had a letter
from you for about 3 weeks
but am in hopes to get one
soon. I guess you had better
not write to me again till
you hear from me, again
I hope we shall get some
money before we go & we
shall if we stop here much
longer I am well & hope

you are the same.

Well I've had a good long
rest & it won't be a great
while before my time is up
There is nothing more to
write about So I will
close up If we get paid
I shall send some money
home
