

Camp Wilson Jan 15/1862

Dear Parents & Sister

I sent you "Ten Dollars"
yesterday morning & wrote you that
I should send this to Greenwood
[?] thought it too much
trouble to have so many coming
to his house after the money
He is one of those d – d Nigger men
I was going to send with F Hawkes
but he wont get ready to send
this month. I may send 3 dollars
more but I guess we shall have
to go south & if we do I may want
some to use
I got a Flag & a Journal last
night from you I have not got
No 5 letter from you yet but
probably shall to night
We have had a regular snow storm

It came about 3 inches deep but
it came fast enough when it did
come but it was so warm that
it melted very fast
We are having easy times of it
We were paid off Monday
morning. Our company were
paid off first this time
We did not get our State pay
this time
If we move from here you will
direct your letters the same I
suppose. I shall write again
Sunday Write as soon as you get
this money.
