Camp Parole Feb 6th 1864

Dear Parents & Sister

Well done. Ive got a
letter the 1st for over 2 weeks
I began to think I was forsaken
certainly. What is the
trouble with the Mail. Every
body has swearing about
letters and the Paymaster for
the past 2 weeks. He telegraphed
here a week ago yesterday for
the Colonel here to have a
Clerk for him as his Clerk
was sick. Since then they have
not heard from him
I sent you a paper the other
day: have you got it. When
you write again put on
3rd Battallion instead of
Company & Regt

for there is a lot of Berdan
sharpshooters here & perhaps
my letters get among them
There is nothing to write
about from here I will
write in a day or so again
It is dinner time & I must
stop You have had a bad time
with your cat don't you
No signs of an exchange yet
Hoping you are all as
well as I am
I remain
